Mumbai: A plucky mother who caught a 36-year-old man on seeing him molest her 11-year-old daughter while they were out for a walk in a park secured the accused was convicted and sentenced to the five-year rigorous imprisonment. Rajhade was in jail since his arrest on May 19, 2020. His bail plea was denied this January. He was produced before the court through video-conferencing on Wednesday.

New Delhi: The CBI has booked managing director and CEO of Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO) U S Awasthi and several others for the alleged irregularities in import of fertilisers.

# Lightning strikes kill 7 in MP's Satna

Gen. Pandey said, "The Army chief said the dialogue process between India and China, both at the operational and military levels, had no common ground. It is a continuous process... It will take time," he said, adding that around 50,000 Indian troops continue to be deployed along the frontier in eastern Ladakh.

"This is an annual activity for us. We all come to our training areas during this particular period. Similarly, China has also come to its training area. But there has been no movement in any area where we have been deployed along the frontier in eastern Ladakh."

The People's Liberation Army (PLA) is so far unable to complete the stalled disengagement at Gogra, Hot Springs and Demchok as well as stop blocking Indian patrols in the strategically located Depsang Plains, as reported by TOI earlier. Moreover, the PLA has also continued to upgrade its military infrastructure along the border.

# May has seen over 75k deaths; 2nd wave moves to the east

The first 19 days of this month have already recorded 75,000 deaths from covid deaths which are by far the highest for any month. Kolkata: Ministers Pritpal Hakim and Subrata Mukherjee as well as former minister Chatterjee remained in custody for at least one more night as the Calcutta high court, after a two-and-a-half-hour hearing on Wednesday, decided to take up their bail pleas and related issues for hearing again on Thursday.

The CBI named Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee and law minister Mooloy Ghatak as parties in their plea for transferring the case out of Bengal and the counsel for the arrested politicians accused the agency of saying "half truths" in court, which was without "precedence in post-Independence India".

The CBI interpreted the CM and the law minister's presence at the court as an attempt to "influence the court complex on Monday as an attempt to 'influence the probe'".

Not so, said the defence, explaining that the act was to "extend support and sympathy" to her senior cabinet colleagues.

Solicitor general Tushar Mehta started his arguments around 2 pm after a division bench of acting Chief Justice Rajesh Bindal and Justice Arjit Banerjee convened virtually. Mehta's arguments followed the formal CBI plea in court, seeking to transfer the Narada case outside Bengal.

"A clear consent and approval" was made by CM Banerjee and other state functionaries "to oversee, impede and intimidate the judicial system and due process of law", he said, submitting photographs and other documents to support the CBI claim.

Advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, who appeared for the arrested politicians, argued that staying their bail order without even giving them a hearing dented their "natural justice".

He also accused the CBI of saying "half truths" in court, like "Awasahama Hain...", in the Maharashtra, as it wanted those leaders in custody at any cost.

Justice Banerjee intervened at this point, saying Monday's HC stay order followed a specific allegation of a judicial order, being given under pressure.

Singhvi countered this by saying the CBI special judge did not mention any such thing in his order.
