

Nowhere to go after testing positive, teen lives on tree

Hyderabad: With nowhere to go and isolate himself after he tested positive for Covid-19, an 18-year-old tribal youth made a makeshift 'isolation bed' for himself on a tree and stayed there for 11 days.

There was no other option. "I was of us — mother, father, sister, brother and I — stay in a one-room house. But their safety, I had decided to stay on a tree," Hamavah Siva Naik told TUI. After spending 11 days in his own 'Covid ward', he was shifted to an isolation centre, which is 7 km away from his residence, and was sent home a day later after he tested negative. A resident of Kohanandikonda, a tribal hamlet in Nalgonda district, Shiva tested positive for Covid-19 on May 4.

On Day 1, he stayed in an open area in front of his house. "While staying there, I got an idea to shift myself to a tree. I secured my bed by tying it to branches using a rope," he said, adding that he spent most of his time reading books and listening to music. He said that he started feeling better by Day 8. He was not scared as he was staying right in front of his house.

Kohanandikonda, which is 196 km from Hyderabad, has a small tribal hamlet with around 500 houses in Adavi-devulapally mandal.

Among the reasons for the high fatality rate, according to the IMA and other doctors in the state, are fewer doctors, which led to exhaustion due to continuous work for over a year now, and lack of social distancing and other Covid-appropriate behaviour in the state. IMA national president-elect Dr Shantanand Prasad Singh said the deaths due to Covid among doctors are spread across Bihar and all age groups, though the majority were above 50.

The IMA Bihar branch's acting state president, Dr Ajay Kumar, said 50 doctors died last year and 90 doctors succumbed this year. He said the maximum number of deaths of doctors in the second wave of the Covid-19 pandemic in the country followed by Uttar Pradesh and Delhi. A total of 90 of the 280 doctors who have died across India from the state, according to the Indian Medical Association.

Complications in the 20-40 age group have been severe. Swift progression is not peculiar to Mumbai and doctors across the state have noticed it. Dr Subram Mestram, professor and head of pulmonary critical care at Government Medical College, Nagpur, said that they have had patients coming with a HbCT score of 2 and 3, which rapidly jumped to 9 and 10 in a span of days. "Such rapid progression of the lung disease was certainly not seen last year," he said.

New Delhi: The Army has an adequate number of troops deployed on the eastern Ladakh frontier to tackle any situation, Army Chief General M Naravane said Wednesday evening as he expressed hope that the continuing military confrontation with China would resolve through dialogue.

He said this dialogue process between India and China, both at the diplomatic and military levels, has not come to a standstill. "It is a continuous process... it will take time," he said, adding that around 70,000-80,000 Indian troops continue to be deployed along the frontier in eastern Ladakh. The People's Liberation Army has so far refused to comment on the alleged deployment of troops in the high-altitude region of Ogera, Hot Springs and Demchok as well as stop blocking Indian patrols in the strategically located Gogra Plains, at a reportedly TPO center. Moreover, the PLA has also continued to upgrade its military infrastructure along the Line of Actual Control in terms of roads, motorbikes, helicopters and surface-to-air missiles, positions in the region. "We are in the process of upgrading our infrastructure development," Gen Naravane said, adding that India was closely monitoring the situation at the time when the PLA has launched its annual summer exercises in its "traditional training areas".

New Delhi: The RSS farm wing, Bhartiya Kisan Sangh, on Wednesday demanded withdrawal of the Centre's recent order on import of pulses which was issued last week to keep retail prices of those commodities under check. It said farmers would not get a better price in a liberalised import regime.

Criticising the government's decision to allow import of pulses like rice and other crops, the BKSS said the move would divert farmers from sowing these crops during the upcoming Kharif season. "This Modi government wants to make India self-sufficient in pulses and oilseeds and we are about to achieve that target, such a move (order to liberalise import) will be contradictory," said Bhatnagar Choudhary, general secretary, BKSS. He said the BKSS demanded the government "to think and address such action immediately to ensure a better price for the pulse farmers".

Backed by increase in acreage of summer sown pulses by over 5 lakh hectares during 2019-20 compared to the previous year, India has during the current crop year recorded production of 24.2 million tonnes of pulses. Choudhary said the order liberalising import of pulses would give a signal to farmers that they shouldn't opt for sowing pulses for 1-1.5 lakh acres. He also raised the issue of deficit faced by the Kisan Credit Card holders in repaying their loan during pandemic.

Mumbai: A plucky mother who caught a 38-year-old man seeing his molester her 11-year-old daughter while they were engaged in a sexual act, was sentenced to five years' rigorous imprisonment. 4 held for stealing phones worth ₹9L

The move will increase the annual subsidy burden by 11,475 crore. The government had hiked the DAP subsidy by 79,500 crore during the current financial year and had not given the break-up for DAP separately in the budget papers.

The development comes at a time when there is wide spread protest in Punjab and Haryana over the government's move to amend the agriculture laws, with farmers' protests still blocking roads at Delhi's borders.

Over the last few months, a spike in fertiliser prices was starting to alarm farmers, but directly transferring Rs 20,867 crore in their account under PM KISAN on the day of Akshay Tritiya, the Prime Minister's Office said in a statement.

Last year, the actual price of DAP was Rs 1,700 per bag and the Centre was giving a subsidy of Rs 560 for every bag resulting in farmers having to pay Rs 1,140.
